1/ ELECTION OF A CHAIR

Councillor Jeremy Paige was elected as committee chair. (Unanimous).

2/ ATTENDANCE AND APOLOGIES :

3/ DECLARATION of INTERESTS :

4/ MACHYNLLETH STREET TREES

Dewi Jones gave a brief verbal report on the Machynlleth Street Trees.

That this Powys (PCC) project was on track, but that work would stop over the summer season so as not to inconvenience businesses and traders during the peak summer months.

5/ ELECTRICITY COSTS

Committee agreed to make the following recommendation to Full Council

That in light of increased utility costs and high usage by traders that the current £5 charge for electricity be tripled to £15. (unanimous).

6/ PUBLIC TOILETS

Dewi Jones gave a brief verbal report to confirm that PCC had not yet submitted a proposal for renovation of the toilet block.

It was recommended that the matter be taken up with Councillor Jackie Charlton of Powys County Council.

7/ ARRANGEMENTS FOR MARKET MANAGEMENT

Councillor Paige reported on the tidying up he had done on the Market Regulations document. Every amendment was discussed individually and agreed unanimously as an improvement on the old regulations.

Committee agreed to make the following recommendation to Full Council, that the document as updated (attached to these minutes) be adopted as the new Market Regulations. (Unanimous).

Dewi Jones then outlined all the work that the Market Traders Rep did in the absence of a Markets Manager.

Fergus Scott left the room whilst the matter was discussed.

Committee agreed to recommend to Full Council that Mr Fergus Scott not be charged for his stall for a period of six months and that the matter be reviewed thereafter. (Unanimous).
